Caritas Community Centre Advisory Committees 2021-2022 Election Arrangement

Background: Caritas Community Centres provide services to residents from their local districts, the advisory committees are responsible for regulating the operations, efficiency and efficacy of such services.

Aims: To motivate members' participation, to strengthen the accountability system, to inform the public of its progress and role and to provide better services for the community.

Polling Date: From 21 November 2020 (Saturday) to 4 December 2020 (Friday)

Polling Hours: Polling will start on 21 November 2020 by post. Polling will end by 4 December 2020. (according to postmark)

Candidate Requirements: Resident of Hong Kong aged 18 or above.
Each candidate needs to be nominated by at least five aged 18 or above members of the centre.

Procedures of Nomination:

- (a) Nomination forms need to be returned within this period: 28 September 2020 (Monday) to 11 October 2020 (Sunday)

Election procedures:

1. Date of election: 21 November to 4 December, 2020
2. Aged 18 or above members, one person one vote, the FIVE candidates with maximum votes will be elected
3. Should the number of successfully nominated candidates exceeds five, the election will be held on the above date.
4. Should the number of nominated candidates be five or less, those candidates will be returned uncontested.

Details of nominees and the polling result will be posted on the notice boards of the centres on 16 October 2020 (Friday) and 10 December 2020 (Thursday) respectively.
